




# DOROTHEA MISSION BIBLE COLLEGE

## IS GOD CALLING YOU?

Every true Christian is called by God to live a holy life and to be a witness for the Lord Jesus. Some, however, need to go into full-time evangelistic ministry. Sinners need to hear the truth today and we need to take it to them. Do you hear the call, *"Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?"* (Isaiah 6:8). If you do, you dare not ignore the Lord's voice. At Dorothea Mission Bible College you can receive the training needed to be an effective evangelist, taking the gospel to the people of southern Africa. We provide both a one year course and an additional two year course. As in the first century, *"the harvest is plentiful, but the labourers are few"* (Matthew 9:37). Perhaps God is calling you.

## THE DOROTHEA MISSION BIBLE COLLEGE

The Dorothea Mission Bible College is a facility of the Dorothea Mission (an independent evangelical faith mission working in southern Africa) for training evangelists. It was originally only for training those who intended working with the Dorothea Mission, but has opened its doors to others as well. The purpose of the training is to equip the students for spiritual work. This includes much more than academic instruction. The


Bible College staff seek to help students in their understanding of Biblical truths, their character, their relationship with the Lord and others and their ministry. Those who don't feel clearly called to full-time evangelistic work, but wish to do one year for spiritual enrichment are also welcome to apply.





During the week classroom instruction is given and there are set times for study. A well-equipped library is available for students to use.

On most weekends students take part in evangelistic outreaches in the vicinity as part of their training. Students are also expected to help with practical tasks on the mission station like maintenance, gardening, etc. as fees are considerably subsidised.



## WHERE IS THE BIBLE COLLEGE?

The Bible College is at the Dorothea Mission station near Rosslyn, 30 km north west of Pretoria. A map with directions is available on request.

## STUDY FEES

The fees for 2014 are as follows:

- Tuition and notes: free
- Meals and accommodation: R1,120 per quarter

The noted fees are payable before each quarter starts. Note that students will also require some extra money for their personal needs. Students are responsible for their own transport, medical and other expenses.

## CERTIFICATES

Successful students receive a Bible College Certificate at the completion of their studies. The certificates are as follows:

- One Year Certificate in Biblical and Evangelistic Ministry
- Three Year Certificate in Biblical and Evangelistic Ministry

Although the training offered compares well with other Bible Colleges, these certificates are not accredited by the South Africa qualifications authority.

### **Other training:**

- Students take part in choir practices and are taught how to use the Mission's library.
- The Dorothea Mission also provides additional practical ministry training, where second and third year students take part in full-time evangelistic outreaches.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- There are new student intakes in January as well as in July.
- Application forms can be requested from the Mission office. Completed forms with required items may be sent to the Bible College at any time, preferably not later than 3 months before intended study.
- If students from outside of South Africa are accepted, the Mission will send them a letter of conditional acceptance. This will help them in ap-

plying for a study permit which they will need to get from the South African Embassy in their country before starting their studies.

- If possible, it will be a help if the applicant can attend our annual mission conference (the "Dorothea Birthday") during September in the year before intended study. We can then get to know him/her, and he/she can get to know the Mission better.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

No academic standard is officially required, but the following is very important:

- All students must be truly born-again Christians, and be assured of their salvation through Jesus Christ.
- All students must be led by the Lord to study at our Bible College. Note that our focus is more on evangelism than pastoral ministry.
- All students should already be in the habit of daily reading God's Word and praying for missions.
- All students should be able to read and understand English.
- All students must fill in the application form and add the information asked for.
- We prefer that students are between 18 and 45 years of age (exceptions are sometimes made).
- We do not have living quarters for married students and their spouses.

The applicant committee will prayerfully consider the applications.
